What we do	
How does Boston Private Wealth LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
How does Boston Private Wealth LLC collect my personal information? Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness <input type="checkbox"/> affiliates from using your information to market to you <input type="checkbox"/> sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Our affiliates include our holding company, Boston Private Financial Holdings, Inc., and our affiliate Boston Private Bank & Trust Company.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Boston Private Wealth LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Boston Private Wealth LLC does not jointly market.</i>
Other Important Information	
<p>For California residents: In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of our corporate family, except as permitted by law, including, for example, with your consent or to service your account. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law. Boston Private Wealth LLC has established standards and practices to comply with the restrictions in limiting the disclosure of information relating to private trusts (including managed agency accounts) for which Boston Private Wealth LLC serves as investment manager.</p> <p>For Massachusetts residents: Boston Private Wealth LLC has established standards and practices to ensure compliance with the provisions of M.G.L. c. 93H and 201 C.M.R. 17.00 in connection with the safeguarding of personal information contained in both paper and electronic records for residents of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.</p>
