What we do	
How does Boston Private Bank & Trust Company protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.  We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Our affiliates include our holding company, Boston Private Financial Holdings, Inc.,
	and our subsidiary Boston Private Wealth, LLC.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	Boston Private Bank & Trust Company does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	Boston Private Bank & Trust Company does not jointly market.

For California residents: In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of our corporate family, except as permitted by law, including, for example, with your consent or to service your account. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law.

Boston Private Bank & Trust Company has established standards and practices to comply with the restrictions in limiting the disclosure of information relating to private trusts (including managed agency accounts) for which Boston Private Bank & Trust Company serves as trustee or investment manager.

**For Massachusetts residents:** Boston Private Bank & Trust Company has established standards and practices to ensure compliance with the provisions of M.G.L. c. 93H and 201 C.M.R. 17.00 in connection with the safeguarding of personal information contained in both paper and electronic records for residents of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
